Sub : Clarification in regard to fixation of pay under Railway Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008.

Ref : Board's letter of even number dated 11/2/2009.


In reference to Board's letter referred above, certain clarifications have been sought from various quarters regarding fixation of pay in the Railway Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008. The doubts raised and the clarifications thereto are as under :-

S No	Point of Doubt	Clarification
1	Whether Grade Pay of Rs.7600/- is admissible on ad hoc promotion to JA Grade alongwith Charge Allowance ?	Grade Pay is admissible only if a person is regularly promoted to a higher post. In cases of ad hoc promotion to JA Grade Grade Pay of Rs.7600/- is not admissible.
2	Whether final settlement of officers who have held the posts in JA Grade on <i>ad hoc</i> basis and also were in service from 1/1/2006 are to be finalized taking into account the Charge Allowance as pay, for the calculation of Pension	Orders for reckoning Charge Allowance as pay for purposes of pension, gratuity etc., have been issued vide Board's letter No.F(E)III/94/PN1/26 dated 23.6.1995. As such, the final settlement of officers who have held the posts in JA Grade on <i>ad hoc</i> basis and are drawing charge allowance may be decided on the basis of these instructions.
3	What will be the charge allowance after the implementation of VI CPC and if charge allowance is to be continued what should be the TA/DA for officers promoted to JA Grade on ad hoc basis ?	TA/DA is already reckoned with reference to the Grade Pay the officer is drawing and in case of SS officers promoted to JA Grade on <i>ad hoc</i> basis their Grade Pay would be Rs.6600/- and TA/DA would be reckoned with reference to this Grade Pay only
